Pianist/Music Minister – Job Description

Madrona Grace Presbyterian Church is accepting applications for a Musician to share in the worship leadership of our congregation. This could be an individual who both plays the piano and directs the choir, or a team of two individuals. Interested applicants should send an email to Rev. Desired Qualifications:

- View [worship](#) leadership as part of her/his personal ministry to Christ and the Church.
- Experience [directing choirs](#) [and leading worship](#).
- Experience playing piano for traditional, contemporary, and/or gospel music.
- Able to site-read music when needed.
- Able to gather and include additional instruments such as drums, guitar, bass, and violin.

Responsibilities:

- Play and direct weekly choir rehearsal and worship services.
- Work with choir to suggest anthems, offertories, and/or special music for worship.
- [Maintain](#) regular [communication](#) with the Pastor and worship team [for planning](#).
- Coordinate substitute musicians when not able to be present.

Hours & Compensation: The MGPC choir meets weekly from September to mid-June. Sunday morning rehearsal starts at 9:30 [AM](#). Worship lasts from 10:30 [AM](#) until around 11:45 [PM](#). When possible midweek, night rehearsals may last for 1-1.5 hours, 2-4 times per month. The rate of pay shall be \$250 per week for music preparation, weekly rehearsal, and playing at service. This will be paid monthly with the submission of invoice.

Supervisor: reports to the [Pastor](#).

Accountability: The Minister of Music shall be accountable to the Pastor and Session (leadership team).
